Gypsy(R) at Black Hills Wild Horse Sanctuary

**Gypsy** is a Mustang mare who came to HPAF in June. She was healthy and at a good weight, but she did not like to be close to people. She is a big, powerful mare and did not want anyone on her left side. We could get up to her on the right, approaching very slowly with food when she was contained in a small space. Often the trauma of a Mustang’s original capture stays with them for life and they remain fearful of humans and contact. Gypsy was not safe to handle or adopt out. If we turned her out into the pasture, there was a chance we might not catch her again. This mare hated captivity and her only chance for a good life was for her to be free again as she once was.

Gypsy was accepted at the Black Hills Wild Horse Sanctuary in South Dakota. **Thank you to Cindy and Jim Thompson** who drove Gypsy and another horse from Florida to South Dakota on a trip that took 3 days and cost over \$1500 in gas alone.

**Susan W. Watt, Program Development, Institute of Range and American Mustang,  
 Black Hills Wild Horse Sanctuary Wrote:**

The Thompsons arrived safely with their wild mare Makali and the other wild mare Gypsy. We unloaded the mares in a corral close to a mixed herd of wild and domestic horses in a fenced area of about 400 acres with hills, trees, and lots of grass. After a week or so I opened the gate for the two mares so they could become a part of the adjoining herd. They both slowly walked out, then came back into the corral with the gate open for a few more days. Then I looked up and they had joined the herd. So quietly, one would never know they were there, as though they did not want to attract attention and have to go back to captivity. Gypsy will remain free for the rest of her life. Thank you for caring about her.
