Casben has a fixed patella, which is a locked stifle and hock, and does not bend at all. After three months of therapy and exercise, he is now trotting and cantering. He is happy, loveable, social and vivacious. In fact, he became so rambunctious that he needed to be gelded, which was done in January with no complications, thank goodness. Because of the results of his injuries, Casben needs to be cleaned every day. He will need continued therapy, controlled exercise, supplements, and acupuncture to help him hopefully get to the point where the patella will unlock. Casben is looking for a home with a special human who will appreciate him for his super special personality and continue his therapy.
